In 2015 the WHO adopted the End TB Strategy; verbalised as “a world free of TB” with “zero deaths, disease and suffering due to TB”; it was accompanied by ambitious targets including: 80% reduction in new patients with TB disease; 90% reduction in TB related-mortality compared to 2015. Recognising social determinants of TB, the strategy is multi-pronged; in this symposium we focus on a single aspect, **diagnosing more patients with TB earlier** in the course of their illness. This symposium includes a diverse group of experiences Wits researchers who will present: modelling the impact of increased TB testing, an example of trial of high volume testing for TB, and the possible future of lab testing for TB.
